1	Annual Pavement Rehab - Various Locations, ST-14-04	Provide asphalt resurfacing to local streets as recommended by the City of Camarillo Pavement Management Plan. Includes Flynn Road Sewer Repairs.	Construction in progress. Change Order work is in progress.
2	Santa Rosa Road Widening, ST-05-01	Widen northwest side of Santa Rosa Road between Via Latina Drive and San Rafael Way to provide four lanes and bike lanes.	Construction continues with paving, curb and gutter, and landscaping work.
3	Sterling Hills Golf Course Sewer Access Road, SS-13-02	Construct sewer access road.	Design complete. Construction anticipated to begin late Spring 2017.
6	Dunnigan Street Traffic Signal, TS-12-01	A traffic signal will be installed at the intersection of Dunnigan Street and Arneill Road.	Project Awarded. Construction is anticipated for early 2017.
7	Undergrounding Project, ST-12-01	Utility undergrounding project between Cedar Drive and Oak Street, and along Las Posas Road from Camarillo Library westerly for a distance based on available funding.	Underground Utility Districts No. 7 Cedar-Oak and No. 8 Las Posas Phase 1 were established on October 14th, 2015. Construction by SCE anticipated to be completed by the end of 2017 for Underground Utility District No. 7 and the end of 2018 for Underground Utility District No. 8.
8	Northeast Pleasant Valley Regional Desalter RO Treatment, WT-11-01	Participation with other regional agencies in design/construction of regional groundwater desalter.	The updated supplemental Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was adopted by City Council on June 20, 2016. On September 28, 2016 the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency (FCGMA) Board approved an allocation of 4,500 acre-feet per year for the City to pump and treat brackish groundwater per an adopted monitoring and contingency plan.



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9	Effluent Diversion Pipeline, SS-10-08	Design/construction of pipeline system to deliver recycled water to potential customers and reduce discharge flows to Conejo Creek required to meet Calleguas Creek 2008 Salts Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL).	Construction is in progress.
10	Renewable Energy Project Implementation, SS-10-07	Project options include installation of solar panels or producing energy from existing digester gas production (co-generation).	Alternative analysis Report complete. Scheduled to be presented to council in Spring 2017.
11	CSD - Pump Station No. 3 Rehabilitation	Rehabilitation of pump station to include: pump upgrades and repiping modifications.	Design underway.
12	ST-15-03, Annual Overlay	Provide asphalt resurfacing to local streets as recommended by the City of Camarillo Pavement Management Plan.	Project was awarded on September 28, 2016. Construction is in progress.
13	ST-15-04, Slurry Seal	Provide slurry seal for local streets as recommended by the City of Camarillo Pavement Management Plan	Construction in progress.
14	WT-14-03, Reclaimed Water Storage Reservoir	Construction of 1 million gallon reclaimed water storage tank at the treatment plant.	Preliminary design complete. Selection of design team to be conducted in early 2017.
15	LB-13-01, Library	Replace distressed trees and revise landscape/irrigation around Library.	Design is underway to revise the grading and drainage since rain gutters installed Fall 2015.
16	CC-11-01, Conference Center drain	Replace existing open channel concrete with precast concrete boxes	Design is approximately 75% complete. Finalizing Cooperative Agreement with VCWPD.
17	SS-11-01, WWTP Flood Improvement	Flood improvements to Wastewater Treatment Plant which may include walls, levees, and/or road improvements	Preliminary design is underway.



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18	ST-04-01, Daily Drive Wall/Monument	Construct wall along north side of Daily Drive from Glenn Drive to Fulton Street. City Monument on Daily Drive at Lewis Road exit from Highway 101 median.	Design is underway. City Council reviewed design concepts on November 2, 2016.
19	ST-15-02, Carmen Drive Median Turf Replacement	Remove and replace turf with water efficient landscaping on Carmen Drive between Paseo Camarillo and Las Posas Road.	Design is underway. City Council reviewed design concepts on November 2, 2016.
20	CH-16-01, City Hall Landscaping	Remove and replace turf with water efficient landscaping.	Design is underway. City Council reviewed design concepts on November 2, 2016.
