



# CITY OF CAMARILLO COMBINED PUBLIC NOTICE

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## AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT FY 2016-17 ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT and PUBLIC HEARING

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In accordance with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, the City of Camarillo will release a Draft FY 2016-17 Action Plan Amendment for a 30-day public review period beginning on November 11, 2016, and ending on December 11, 2016.

The FY 2016-17 Action Plan, approved by City Council on May 11, 2016, provides a comprehensive one-year strategy that addresses the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). On September 28, 2016, City Council approved an amendment to the FY 2016-17 Action Plan to include a new rental housing rehabilitation program. On December 14, 2016, City Council will consider another amendment to the FY 2016-17 Action Plan to include the Habitat for Humanity's Preserve-A-Home program. This program provides assistance in the form of a low-interest loans or grants to lower-income homeowners to help with necessary property repairs.

The Draft 2016-17 Action Plan Amendment will be available for public review at the Community Development Department, located at Camarillo City Hall, 601 Carmen Drive; at the Camarillo Library, located at 4101 Las Posas Road; and on the City's website, at [www.cityofcamarillo.org](http://www.cityofcamarillo.org).

The Camarillo City Council will conduct a **public hearing on Wednesday, December 14, 2016**, at 7:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers located at 601 Carmen Drive, to receive public comments on the Draft FY 2016-17 Action Plan Amendment and to approve the final document for submittal to HUD. All interested persons are encouraged to submit comments on the draft amendment on, or before, the December 14, 2016 public hearing.
